

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in a special called meeting at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Charles Fagan, Council Members Mary Bramblett, Ed Hanson, Bill Baker and Doug Goss. Council Members John Lawrence, Eddie Baldwin and Kevin Farmer were absent.

Mayor Fagan declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order.

Mayor Fagan presented documents for review relating to the pre-pay gas proposal from SEAGD. The Council members discussed the proposal with input from Water, Gas & Sewer Manager Lee Young. Doug Goss advised he was not comfortable with accepting the proposal due to the short review period. After further discussion and comments Doug Goss made the motion not to adopt and approve the pre-pay gas proposal at this time. Ed Hanson seconded the motion and the motion carried by unanimous consent.

In other business Bill Baker discussed the JOB's program available through DHR that allows persons on welfare to be hired by local business and government at no cost with their salaries being paid through the state agency. Lee Young also discussed the opportunity to negotiate for water sales to Calhoun County and the need to drill a test well on Hwy. 278 near the water plant.

There being no visitors comments and no further business to come before the Council Mayor Fagan declared the meeting adjourned sine die at 7:14pm.
