

CITY COUNCIL
CITY OF PIEDMONT
MAY 2ND, 2017
6:00 PM

The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Bill Baker, Council Members Ben Keller, Mary Bramblett, Doug Dickeson, Matt Rogers, Greg South, Bobby Hardin and Terry Kiser.

Following the invocation given by Doug Dickeson and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Mary Bramblett made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Doug Dickeson seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

The bills totaling \$410,439.36 were then presented for consideration for payment. Terry Kiser made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Matt Rogers seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment unanimously.

The Mayor asked for consideration of Resolution 2017-02 which is a municipal water pollution annual report. Mary Bramblett made the motion to adopt Resolution 2017-02. Terry Kiser seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

The Mayor then asked for consideration of Resolution 2017-03 which is the annual match for the Section 5311 Nonurbanized Area Public Transportation. Terry Kiser made the motion to adopt Resolution 2017-03. Ben Keller seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

In Other Business Terry Kiser made the motion to sale the skate park property to the Piedmont Rescue Squad in the amount of \$8,510.00. Matt Rogers seconded the motion and the Mayor asked the City Clerk for a roll call vote and the vote was as follows:

Following the roll call the vote was 6 yeas and 2 nays with the majority voting to sale the skate park property to the Piedmont Rescue Squad.

Bobby Hardin made the motion to appoint Ricky Freeman, Theresa Ingram, Anita Norton, Kenny Holbrooks and Sheila LeRoy to the cemetery board to fill the vacancies and to stagger the terms. Doug Dickeson seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Next Doug Dickeson made the motion to allow Jesse McKnight to spend the \$8,900.00 to purchase handbooks and to have 15 employees receive their gas certification.

Greg South made a motion that starting the first week of June the Piedmont Museum be opened on Fridays and Saturdays. Matt Rogers seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

Mary Bramblett had no report.

Doug Dickeson had no report.

Matt Rogers asked if someone could come to the next safety meeting to discuss 457-B plan to the employees.

Greg South had no report.

Bobby Hardin had no report.

In the Mayor's Comments the Mayor asked the Council for permission to post in the paper that Dr. Gao and Dr. Gavino have so many days to remove their items from the buildings they occupied through the City. Terry Kiser made the motion to post in the paper. Mary Bramblett seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
