The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Bill Baker, Council Members Ben Keller, Mary Bramblett, Matt Rogers, Bobby Hardin and Terry Kiser.

Following the invocation given by Mayor Baker and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Mary Bramblett made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Terry Kiser seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

The bills totaling \$205,223.99 were then presented for consideration for payment. Ben Keller made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Matt Rogers seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment unanimously.

The Mayor asked for consideration of Ordinance 632 which would establish the qualifying fee for the 2020 Municipal Election. The fee would be \$25.00 to qualify to run for a municipal office. Mary Bramblett made the motion to suspend the rules for immediate consideration of Ordinance 632.
