The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Baker, Council Members Ben Keller, Mary Bramblett, Doug Dickeson, Greg South, Bobby Hardin and Terry Kiser.

Following the invocation given by Doug Dickeson and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes were presented for consideration. Mary Bramblett made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Doug Dickeson seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

The bills totaling \$405,703.03 were then presented for consideration for payment. Ben Keller made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Matt Rogers seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment unanimously.

The Mayor asked for consideration of Resolution 2020-01 which is an abatement to cut the grass at 125 Haslem Street. Doug Dickeson made the motion to adopt Resolution 2020-01. Terry Kiser seconded the motion and Resolution 2020-01 passed unanimously.

In Visitor's Comment Lane Weatherbee asked the Council to consider naming the back alley at West Ladiga St and the Chief Ladiga Trail so that the County could pave the alley for future businesses coming to this area. Mary Bramblett made the motion to name the alley Trail Park Drive. Doug Dickeson seconded the motion and the Mayor asked the City Clerk for a roll call and the vote was as follows:
