CITY COUNCIL CITY OF PIEDMONT JUNE 1ST, 2021 6:00 PM

The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Baker, Council Members John Lawrence, Richard Williams, Jubal Feazell, Caleb Pope, Greg South, David Ivey and Terry Kiser.

Following the invocation given by Jubal Feazell and the pledge of allegiance to the flag the minutes of the previous meeting were presented for consideration. Terry Kiser made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Caleb Pope seconded the motion and the minutes were approved unanimously.

The bills totaling \$252,729.19 were then presented for consideration for payment. Greg South made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. David Ivey seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment unanimously.

Jubal Feazell made the motion to appoint Greg South to be the AMEA Election Committee Member. Terry Kiser seconded the motion and the motion carried with Greg South abstaining.

Richard Williams made the motion not to allow Jackie Black to de-annex from the city limits of Piedmont. Caleb Pope seconded the motion and the mayor asked the city clerk for a roll call and the vote was as follows:

Next Terry Kiser made a motion to amend Ordinance 631 section 4-12 to allow up to eight hens in a contained area within the city limits. Jubal Feazell seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

After some discussion concerning manufactured home Jubal Feazell made the motion to follow the zoning ordinance that is already in place but adding an exception allowing the footprint of the

manufactured home to change based on the property lines. Richard Williams seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

In Council Reports John Lawrence had no report. Richard Williams had no report. Jubal Feazell asked that everyone support the July 3rd downtown event and that there would be a meeting at the civic center on Thursday at 6:00 pm. Caleb Pope had no report. Greg South had no report. David Ivey said the Memorial Day ceremony for the Veterans was very well put together and everyone did a good job.

Terry Kiser had no report.

In the Mayor's Comments the Mayor said the Memorial event for Veterans was outstanding and the downtown event needed to be made bigger and better. He informed the council that the piping at the park will not happen until the fall. He also said the paving behind Mapco will happen in the next 3 to 4 weeks.
