The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Baker, Council Members John Lawrence, Richard Williams, Jubal Feazell, Caleb Pope, David Ivey, and Terry Kiser.

Following the invocation and the pledge of allegiance given by Mayor Baker, the minutes were presented for consideration. Terry Kiser made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Caleb Pope seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

The bills totaling \$299,495.38 were then presented for consideration for payment. Richard Williams made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Jubal Feazell seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment.

Resolution 2022-15 was next on the agenda. David Ivey made the motion to approve Resolution 2022-15. Terry Kiser seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

The next item was Resolution 2022-16. Terry Kiser made the motion to approve Resolution 2022-16. Richard Williams seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

The next item was Resolution 2022-17. Richard Williams made the motion to approve Resolution 2022-17. David Ivey seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.

The rezoning of property owned by Gary Price was our next item. The Zoning Board made the recommendation to the Council to rezone this property from R-1 to HC. Terry Kiser made the motion to rezone the Gary Price property on Memorial Drive from R-1 to HC. David Ivey seconded the motion and Mayor Baker asked for a roll call vote.

The votes were 6-1 in favor in the rezoning so the motion passed.

Terry Kiser wanted to echo all that David said.

Clerk Hinton spoke with Jerry Cash on the mounting brackets and he is trying to get a definite date for delivery. Clerk Hinton had reached out to Robert Sadler concerning the Civic Center drainage and will have an estimate at the next meeting.

In the Mayor's Comments he wanted to thank Terry and Ashley from the Entertainment Committee for the work they did for the July 4th Celebration. He wanted to thank ALL City employees for the jobs they do. He also wanted to tell Council how much he appreciates working with them.

With no other business to come before the Council, Caleb Pope made the motion that the meeting be adjourned. Terry Kiser seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 6:24 pm.
