The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Baker, Council Members John Lawrence, Richard Williams, Jubal Feazell, Greg South, David Ivey, and Terry Kiser.

Following the invocation and the pledge of allegiance given by Mayor Baker, the minutes were presented for consideration. Terry Kiser made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. David Ivey seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

The bills totaling \$730,376.30 were then presented for consideration for payment. Jubal Feazell made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. Richard Williams seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment.

The next order of business was Resolution 2022-27. David Ivey made the motion to approve Resolution 2022-27. Jubal Feazell seconded the motion and the motion carried.

After the Police and Fire reports the Mayor asked for Visitor Comments. There were no visitor comments.

In Council reports John Lawrence had NO report.

Richard Williams would like to see the Rescue Squad contract on the agenda next meeting. He would like to see a \$75,000 per year payment and a five year with five year extension on the contract.

Jubal Feazell talked about the need for a fill in at the Filter Plant. He also mentioned about a grant from Alabama Power Company and asked if the City could look at the requirements.

Caleb Pope was absent.

Greg South had NO report.

David Ivey had NO report.

Terry Kiser would like for the police check speeding on Main Street. He asked the City to get a price on portable speed limit device.

Clerk Hinton asked Council to consider paying for a new lift station on South 5th Avenue out of Rescue Money. He wanted to let everyone know that the dozer is up and running. He asked the Council if he could begin looking for a trailer for the new dozer.

In the Mayor's Comments he wanted to thank the rescue squad for all they do. He wanted to let everyone know about the release of funds from ADEM for water and sewer grants. He also wanted to welcome Michael Blake from WEIS radio to the Council meeting.

With no other business to come before the Council, Terry Kiser made the motion that the meeting be adjourned. Greg South seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 6:06 pm.
