The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Baker, Council Members John Lawrence, Richard Williams, Caleb Pope, Greg South, David Ivey, and Terry Kiser.

Following the invocation and the pledge of allegiance given by Mayor Baker, the minutes were presented for consideration. Terry Kiser made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Greg South seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

The bills totaling \$411,875.90 were then presented for consideration for payment. Greg South made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. David Ivey seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment.

The next order of business was the ABC License application from WM Grocery for beer and wine sales. Greg South made the motion to approve the license application. Caleb Pope seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The 2022-2023 Budget was next on the agenda. David Ivey made the motion to approve the budget as presented. Caleb Pope seconded the motion and the Budget passed.

The Short term Rental Ordinance discussion was next. The Council agreed to discuss further at the next Council meeting. Clerk Hinton will be getting a few more ordinances to review,

The Chief of Police supplied the Council with information on a Safe Zone. This would be located at the Municipal Court Building with the last two parking spaces closest to the Fire Department allotted for the Safe Zone. David Ivey made the motion to approve the Safe Zone. Terry Kiser seconded the motion and the motion carried. The monies will come from Crime Prevention Fund to purchase the camera.

After the police and fire reports there were No visitor comments.

In Council Reports, John Lawrence had NO report.

Jubal Feazell was absent.

Caleb Pope said the Short Term Rental insurance was provided by the organization.
