The City of Piedmont is offering at sealed bid, for LAWNCARE FOR HIGHLAND CEMETERY for the City of Piedmont. The bid will contain a MONTHLY price and will be on schedule for being cut twice per month for duration of the 2023 grass season. This bid also includes the trimming of shrubs, picking up limbs, picking up trash, and disposing of flowers not on graves. These duties will be performed on an as-needed basis. The cutting will begin in April and end in October. The schedule of twice a month cutting will remain in effect unless City officials deem it necessary to change. This change could be a result of weather conditions, too much rain or not any at all. The City will allow the spraying of herbicides which is limited to ditch bottoms, road ways, and non-grassy lots. The Cemetery must be cut before special holidays such as Easter, Mother's Day, and Father's Day. Verification of current state/city license, insurance, and qualifications shall be required prior to acceptance of bid.

The City of Piedmont is offering at sealed bid, for LAWNCARE FOR CHIEF LADIGA TRAIL for the City of Piedmont. The bid will contain a MONTHLY price and will be on schedule for being cut twice per month for duration of the 2023 grass season. This bid also includes the trimming of shrubs, remulching around trees and flower beds as needed, blowing off trail, picking up fallen limbs, trimming limbs, and disposal thereof. The width of the cut on the trail should be from tree line to tree line whenever possible. All trail maintenance should be completed by the end of business on Thursday of each week. These duties will be performed on an as-needed basis. The cutting will begin in April and end in October. The schedule of twice a month cutting will remain in effect unless City officials deem it necessary to change. This change could be a result of weather conditions, too much rain or not any at all. The Welcome Center, and from Wagon Road to Complex entrance will be cut weekly. Trail must be cut before special events, races, or Holidays. Verification of current state/city license, insurance, and qualifications shall be required prior to acceptance of bid.

The City of Piedmont will include a bid sheet to be returned with your bid on it. The Chief Ladiga Trail and Highland Cemetery will be bid together as ONE package. If you do NOT bid on the Cemetery or Trail then your bid will be null and void. The bid sheet will ask for a monthly price for the Trail and the Cemetery. Those two totals will be added together for a TOTAL monthly cut price for both places.
