The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Baker, Council Members John Lawrence, Richard Williams, Jubal Fezell, Caleb Pope, Greg South, David Ivey, and Terry Kiser.

Following the invocation by Jubal Fezell and the pledge of allegiance given by Mayor Baker, the minutes were presented for consideration. Terry Kiser made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Caleb Pope seconded the motion and the minutes were approved. David Ivey abstained.

The bills totaling \$335,378.04 were then presented for consideration for payment. Richard Williams made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. David Ivey seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment.

The next item on the agenda was the Convenience Fee. Greg South made the motion to implement a 3 % fee effective October 1, 2023. Terry Kiser seconded the motion and the motion carried.

David Ivey reported to the Council to please do work orders for missing or faded stop signs and street signs that need repairing or replacing.

Terry Kiser requested getting our financial reports that we get on the second meeting of the month be given quarterly. After discussion from the Council, he withdrew his request.

Clerk Hinton told the Council we are out of dumpsters and we have people on a waiting list. Clerk Hinton put a quote on the packet. Richard Williams made the motion to purchase 10 – 4 yard dumpsters, 10 – 6 yard dumpsters, and 10 – 8 yard dumpsters for \$40,124.00 and the dumpsters will be paid by Rescue Money. Caleb Pope seconded the motion and the motion carried.

In the Mayor's comments he reported that we had a few pop up storms with down trees and power loss over the weekend. He appreciates the work from the City workers who helped with storm clean up.

With no other business to come before the Council, Greg South made the motion that the meeting be adjourned. Terry Kiser seconded the motion and the meeting adjourned at 6:02 pm.
