The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Baker, Council Members Richard Williams, Jubal Feazell, Greg South, David Ivey, and Terry Kiser.

Following the invocation by David Ivey and the pledge of allegiance given by Mayor Baker, the minutes were presented for consideration. Terry Kiser made the motion that the minutes be approved as presented. Greg South seconded the motion and the minutes were approved.

The bills totaling \$519,492.21 were then presented for consideration for payment. Greg South made the motion that the bills be approved as presented. David Ivey seconded the motion and the bills were approved for payment. Terry Kiser abstained.

The next item on the agenda was the Alabama Cybersecurity Grant. Terry Kiser made the motion to proceed with the application for participation in the State of Alabama's SLCGP Program. Jubal Feazell seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Resolution 2023-21 was next on the agenda. Greg South made the motion to approve Resolution 2023-21. Richard Williams seconded the motion and the motion carried.

After the Police and Fire Reports, there were no visitor comments.

In Council reports, John Lawrence was absent.

Richard Williams wanted to thank the Street Department for cutting right of ways in District 2.

Jubal Feazell gave information for the Anniston Star Reader's Choice Awards. Josh Parker from Police, Richard McCain from Fire, and Chief Nathan Johnson were all recognized.

Caleb Pope was absent.
