The City Council of the City of Piedmont met in regular session at the time and on the date above. Present were Mayor Baker, Council Members Richard Williams, Jubal Feazell, Caleb Pope, Greg South, David Ivey, and Terry Kiser.

The Mayor asked for a motion to go into executive session. Terry Kiser made the motion to go into executive session. Richard Williams seconded the motion and the motion carried.

PARD registration increases and a new computer program for the Parks and Recreation Department was tabled to the next meeting. Terry Kiser made the motion to table it. Caleb Pope seconded the motion and the motion carried.

In visitor's comments, Tim Langley told how the City does a great job. He is very happy to live here. He asked the City to look at the refuse truck pick up schedule.

In Council reports, John Lawrence was absent.

Richard Williams had no report.

Jubal Feazell had questions about the knuckle boom trucks. He asked if both trucks were still down. He also mentioned the overgrown ROW issues all over town.

Caleb Pope stated that rental owners need to be liable for trash and junk left after a tenant moves out. He told everyone about the Crap Run that will be Saturday and band competition will be Oct 14.

Greg South said that he would still like to see dumpsters put around town for people to dump in. He also thanked the City for putting decorations downtown at the gazebo.
